


AUDIOSTORM VOLUME BOX

The Audiostorm Volume Box (and VB Hi-Z) are designed to give you greater control over your signal levels at critical points so that you can achieve an improved sound.

Use case 1


Place the unit in an amplifier effects loop. Connect send to in, and out to return. Using the volume box to reduce your levels will give you greater control over amplifier volume and also allow you to turn your pre-amp controls higher than usual for a more intense overdrive.



Use case 2


Place the volume box at the end of an effects chain and before the amplifier input. When used with loud, overly sensitive non master volume type amplifiers this can give you much more control and precision.

Your volume box can also be used in the middle of a signal chain or with studio equipment. This is particularly useful where a sensitive effect or studio device might be expecting a lower-level signal and it can result in a cleaner sound.



Use case 3

If you use a non master volume amp, a high output guitar, an instrument with no volume control, want to match multiple guitars with different output levels, or need a lower level for a vintage effect, then using the Box as the first item in your chain will give you more control over your tone.



When using passive pickups a Hi-Z volume box may be preferred because it causes less loading and minimises HF roll-off.
